



## ADVISORY COMMITTEE POLICIES FOR 2008

The 4-H Advisory Committee has agreed upon the following policies for the coming year.

1. We will collect a membership fee of \$7.00 per member paid only one time if in multiple clubs. This fee will not be required of those members participating in the county-wide fundraiser. **There will be a PENTALTY to the club of \$3.00 per member if dues are not paid by July 1.**
2. The Countywide fundraiser this year will be Kathryn Beich Candy Bars. Pickup dates will be April 14<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>. The Advisory Committee will offer clubs a profit of \$10.00 per box of 40 candy bars. The Countywide Fundraiser will give the clubs and their members the opportunity to pay for their county membership dues and have a profit to use as the club and members see fit (i.e. camp scholarships, project books, etc.).

Enrollments folders will be verified by the Advisory Committee. At that time a statement will be sent to the clubs for payment of fees. Checks only for the Enrollment fees per statement will be sent to the 4-H Advisory Treasurer who's address will be on the statement.

Clubs may want to consider paying this membership fee with their treasury money rather than asking each member. If you have members who are unable to pay for any reason, paying with treasury money or having the member participate in the countywide fundraiser will cover this cost.
