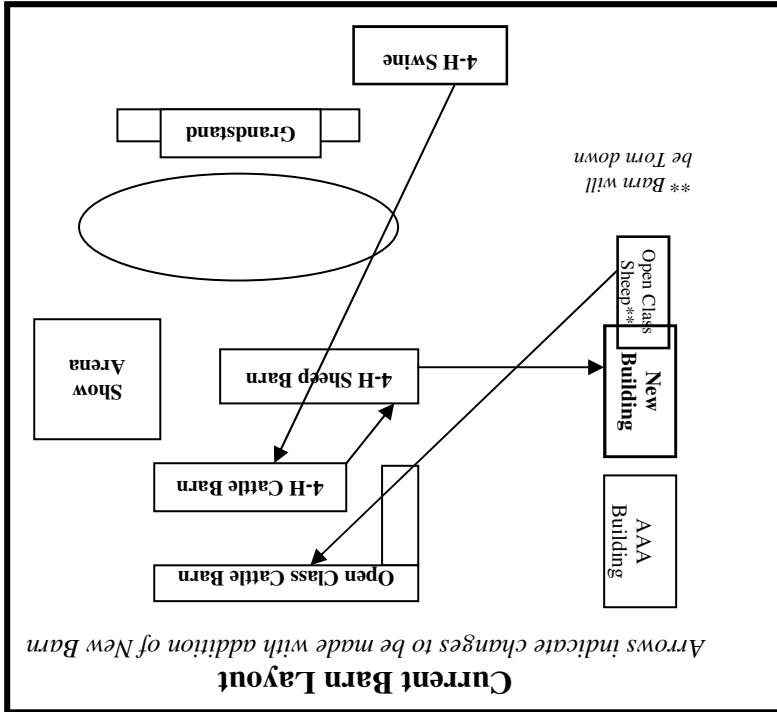

The Plan:

1. **Remove** Open Class Metal Sheep Building
2. Replace Open Class Sheep Barn with new 60' x 160' clear span, 9600 sq ft building in line with AAA building
3. Renovate current Sheep Barn to house Junior Cattle
4. Renovate current Cattle Barn to house Junior Swine
5. Renovate current Swine Barn to house Junior Rabbits & Poultry
6. Relocate Junior Fair exhibits to existing Rabbit Bldg
7. Relocate Commercial Exhibits to existing Poultry Bldg
8. Relocate Jr. Fair exhibits from Art Hall to Jr. Fair Display Bldg
9. Relocate Senior Fair exhibits to Art Hall
10. Hold Junior Fair Goat, Rabbit, Poultry & Small Animal Shows and Hall of Champions in current Swine Arena

Benefits:

1. Every swine exhibitor will have their own pen
2. More large animal exhibitors will utilize Show Arena
3. Adequate seating for all livestock shows
4. Rabbit & Poultry exhibits won't be triple stacked
5. Current Swine Arena will provide a great atmosphere for the Goat, Rabbit, Poultry, & Small Animal Shows
6. Space will be available for other non-show related events in the current Swine Arena
7. Swine Arena will house the Hall of Champions
8. Senior Fair Board will have the option of hosting larger events with 2 buildings to rent together
9. Easier for Jr. exhibitors to care for more than one species
10. Convenient for buyers with all sales in Show Arena

Barn Raising Campaign Donation Options

The total project cost is estimated to be approx. \$400,000 which includes the new building, new pens for the sheep and swine buildings, and necessary renovations to the existing buildings. There is currently \$220,000 (Senior Fair Board contribution and past donations) already appropriated.

Personal Pen License For the Swine Barn
 A Personal Pen License may be purchased for \$300. Each donor will receive a personalized plate that will be displayed on a swine pen for the life of the pen. (Maximum 50 characters)
 There is a potential of raising \$75,000 if all 250 pens were sponsored.

Personal Pen License For the Sheep Barn
 A Personal Pen License may be purchased for \$300. Each donor will receive a personalized plate that will be displayed on a sheep pen for the life of the pen. (Maximum 50 characters)
 There is a potential of raising \$45,000 if all 150 pens were sponsored.
