

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:**

**Where can I find the application(s) I need?** All forms are available at the Fairfield County Extension Office or on-line at: <http://fairfield.osu.edu/4h/4hforms.htm>

**Where can I get help with this form?** Club advisors and members who have previously completed an Achievement Form are great resources. 4-H staff is always willing to sit down and work with anyone interested in completing a form. (Strangely enough, they really enjoy this process and are willing to help you at any point). Call 740-653-5419 x19 or email [kohler.61@osu.edu](mailto:kohler.61@osu.edu) to schedule an appointment.

**Do I have to fill out an Achievement Form to be a Junior Leader?** No, Junior Leaders can be added to the mailing list by checking the Junior Leadership box on the front page of their Achievement Form or by simply calling the office to be added to the mailing list.

**How can I get on Junior Fair Board at the county level?** A Committee selects 4-H representatives to the Junior Fair Board by reviewing the completed Achievement Form of interested applicants. They select enough members for the number of positions open to 4-H in that year. Interested applicants must complete an Achievement Form and selection process.

**How do I get to be Camp Counselor?** Members who have been counselors in the past can complete the interest sheet that indicates they would like the opportunity to return as a counselor. Members who have not counseled before complete the response form indicating they would like an application. The Camp Counselor Application form will then be sent out to them and is due back in January.

**How do I get to be a State 4-H Ambassador?** Members who want to be a State Ambassador need to complete and return the Ohio 4-H Ambassador Application. This form is available upon request at the Extension Office.

**How can I get a 4-H Scholarship?** Completion of the Ohio 4-H Scholarship Application and resume qualifies a member for county and state 4-H scholarships. These forms are available at the Extension Office and are due in early January.

**When are the Achievement Forms due?** All completed forms are due into the Fairfield County Extension Office by January 11, 2007.
