***Carmel, Krunch, Almonds and new this year Dark Chocolate!!!***

There will be four flavors of chocolate bars sold for \$1.00 each: Carmel, Krunch, Almonds, and Dark Chocolate. There is a 50% profit, that will be broken down as follows, for each bar sold: your 4-H club will keep 25 cents and turn in 75 cents (of which 50 cents goes to pay for the bars and 25 cents of which will go to the 4-H Advisory Committee's general fund).

**NOTE:** The 4-H club selling the highest total number of candy bars will receive an award.

**The 4-H Committee will be collecting a membership fee of \$7.00 per member. This fee will not be required of those members selling 1 or more boxes of candy. The clubs will decide how they will spend their \$10.00 profit/box of candy sold.**

Candy can be picked up no earlier than Monday, April 14 between 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., at the Extension office. Candy pick-up is on a first-come, first-serve basis but there should be plenty. For ease of handling, bars are pre-packed with 20-Carmels, 12-Krunch, 6-Almonds and 2 Dark Chocolate in each box. We can get additional candy on a couple days' notice, so do not hesitate to request more if you need it. However, re-orders will be filled only if a reasonable payment is made. **(checks only please)**. This will help tremendously with bookkeeping. All candy remaining in the club's possession becomes the club's! Final payment (check or money order) is due **May 9<sup>th</sup>**.
