



4-H Cultural Immersion Project – Puerto Rico

November 26 – December 3, 2019 – Castañer, Puerto Rico

The best way to understand a different culture is to immerse yourself in it. Apply to be part of the Cultural Immersion project experience in Puerto Rico. You will build multicultural skills and understanding, as well as an increased ability to communicate in the increasingly diverse society that we live in. You will experience both the Old San Juan urban area as well as life in the remote mountain town of Castañer. We will also be working with 4-H youth from Puerto Rico in joint service projects around the island.

Teens ages 15-18 are eligible for this 7-day service-learning experience. The cost of the experience is \$400 plus airfare (est. \$650). Limited scholarship funds are also available.

Where: Puerto Rico (both Old San Juan and mountain village of Castañer)

Application Deadline: August 15th, 2019
Cost: \$400 plus airfare -- (Approximately \$650)
