Please use the electronic copy of the form available at go.osu.edu/19JuniorFairEntry if at all possible. OSU Extension will have a computer for you to complete the form on if you do not have access to one at home. You may make additional copies of this form as needed or contact OSU Extension - Fairfield County for additional copies.

Members will receive premiums on only their two (2) highest paying entries.

Please note that projects to be judged at the fair must be entered. These include: Cake Decorating, Pies, Candies, Dogs, Small Animals, Other Creatures, Grazing, Crops, Gardening and all Livestock projects. **Projects that were judged/graded in the summer do not need to be entered. (Cake decorating judged during the summer does not make an entry - refer to member's handbook)**

DIRECTIONS TO FAIRGROUNDS OFFICE: Enter fairgrounds through the Broad Street gate and make an immediate right. Proceed to the red brick administration building. The Jr Fair Entrance is the door on the right.
