

2020 Fairfield Co Junior Fair Updates

Book 12 – 4-H/FFA Crops

Superintendents – Fairfield County Ag Teachers

ARRIVAL TIME: 4-H Exhibitors will bring all garden and crop projects with them to the 4-H Display Barn between 1:00 – 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 10th. OSU Extension Staff will take project and project books from the exhibitors to display for judging in the 4-H Display Barn. FFA Exhibitors should drop off their FFA crop projects to their FFA advisor at the school by Friday, October 9th.

HOUSING: Garden and Crop projects will be housed in the 4-H Display Barn to be judged during fair week. The 4-H Display Barn will not be open to spectators or visitors.

SHOW TIME: Judging for Crop and Shop projects will take place on Monday (project area will be closed at this time for judging). Awards will be posted with the other award Press Releases outside of the Junior Fair Office on the wall.

RELEASE TIME:

- 4-H Crop and Gardening Exhibitors should indicate at dropoff if they wish to discard or return and pickup their exhibit items. If they wish to return and pickup their exhibit items, they can be picked up in the Junior Fair Office starting on Tuesday.
- FFA Crop and Gardening Exhibits will be handled by county FFA advisors.

PREMIUMS: Premiums will not be issued for 2020.

ADDITIONAL RULES:

1. 4-H Members are to bring their completed project books with them to the assigned drop off time.
2. 4-H and FFA members are not present for Fairfield County Junior Fair crop judging.
3. Social Distancing – There is plenty of space in the barn to spread out and maintain 6 feet of separation between each exhibitor.
4. Everyone present in the barn is **REQUIRED** to wear a mask, must be socially distanced from other families and must leave the building when their exhibitor's project is dropped off.
5. Hand Sanitizing stations will be available for exhibitors, families and show volunteers. Please be aware of their location and use them as needed to keep your hands clean.
