Note: This skillathon is to see what you know. It is NOT competitive this year. It is only to gauge what our youth know.

- Use the Wayne County Animal Science Learning Lab to study for the skillathon and your 4-H reference book for your species. <https://wayne.osu.edu/skillathon-study-materials>
- You must complete at least 1 specie skillathon in order to show at the Fairfield County Junior Fair.
- If you are competing for premier exhibitor, you must complete the skillathon in that specie.
- Skillathon links will be emailed to you September 1st. Skillathons are to be completed by September 21st. If you do not have a computer or internet access, appointments may be made to take the skillathon at the Fairgrounds on September 20th.
- Skillathons are set up in 5-6 sections:
 - Two-three sections will be topics from the species-specific lists
 - One topic will be Quality Assurance (or EquiSTEP for horses)
 - One topic will be feed tag related
 - The final section will be sharing information about your project

Dates: Skillathon links released on September 1st.
Skillathon links close at 8 pm on September 21st.

If you do not have a computer or internet to complete the skillathon, please contact the OSU Extension office to schedule an appointment to complete the virtual skillathon at the fairgrounds on Sunday, September 20th. Appointments will be available in the afternoon.

- Skillathon links will be released on September 1, 2020
- You can complete the skillathon once you receive a link
- It can only be completed ONCE.
- We ask that youth complete it on their own; if they need assistance with reading, parents/guardians are allowed to assist with that only
- This skillathon is not a competition. It is for COMPLETION
- The skillathon links will close at 8 pm on September 21st.
- You will receive your completion score immediately after you complete the skillathon.
- The last section of the skillathon will ask you questions regarding your record book such as breed of animal, weight or what are you feeding.
