

## **2020 Fairfield County Junior Fair Updates**

### **Book 8 – Pygmy Goat**

**ARRIVAL TIME:** Pygmy Goats can be brought into the fairgrounds Sunday, October 11<sup>th</sup> between 12:00 – 2:00 p.m. Animals must be in their assigned stalls by 2:00 p.m. in the west wing of the Round Cattle Barn. Exhibitors should check in with the Pygmy Goat Superintendent during this time.

**HOUSING:** Pygmy Goats will be housed in empty assigned stalls in the west wing of the Round Cattle Barn. Exhibitors will stall with other members of their family (if applicable) or be spaced out from other exhibitors to maintain 6 feet of distance between animals and exhibitors. There will be no decorating of pens this year.

**BEDDING:** Exhibitor Preference. Pens and tack must be removed no later than Monday, October 12<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m.

**WEIGH-IN TIMES:** N/A

**SHOWMANSHIP:** Showmanship sign-ups will be done via an electronic survey that will be shared with all exhibitors. Exhibitors have until 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 11<sup>th</sup> to sign up. Classes will be broken by age. Link to sign-up for showmanship:

**SHOW TIME:** The Pygmy Goat Show will be in the Round Cattle Barn Show Arena starting at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, October 12<sup>th</sup>.

#### **ADDITIONAL RULES:**

1. There will be no physical contact between the judge and the exhibitors.
2. Exhibitors in the ring and the judge will not be required to wear a mask but everyone else will be wearing a mask in the building.
3. Social Distancing – There is plenty of space in the arena to spread out and try to maintain 6 feet of separation between each exhibitor.
4. Announcements will be made during the show to remind spectators, families and exhibitors to stay socially distanced.
5. Spectators will only be allowed in the show arena while their exhibitor is showing. Spectators are **REQUIRED** to wear a mask, must be socially distanced from other families and must leave the building when their exhibitor's class is over. Spectators can stand around the ring leaving at least 6 feet distance from the next family unit. This will be strictly enforced. Failure to comply with these standards could result in removal from the grounds or the show being stopped.
6. Hand Sanitizing stations will be available for exhibitors, families and show volunteers. Please be aware of their location and use them as needed to keep your hands clean.
