



#### What is 4-H?

- A non-formal educational, youth development organization for boys and girls.
- 2. Project clubs are open to youth age 8 and in 3rd grade or age 9 up to youth who who are 18 as of January 1st
- 3. Cloverbud clubs are open to youth who are age 5 and in Kindergarten up to 8 years of age as of January 1st

### Why 4-H?

- All 4-H programs focus on active involvement and quality experiences which stimulate lifelong learning of values and skills.
- 2. Engage in fun and educational experiences with their friends and family at meetings, social activities, tours, camps, judging and fairs.
- Learn by doing interesting things such as taking projects of their choosing and performing community service.

# When is the best time to join 4-H?

The best time to join 4-H really depends on the club's meeting schedule. Try to contact the club in the winter or early spring so you can make your decision prior to the enrollment deadline which is **April 15<sup>th</sup>**.

You can also attend the 4-H Day, the first Saturday in March from 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. at the AAA Building at the Fairfield County Fairgrounds. Current 4-H members will display their projects and be available to share information about their 4-H experiences. Information about specific clubs will be available as well as the opportunity to join 4-H.

# Finding a Club for Your Family

- 1. Find a club that accepts members within your child's age range. Cloverbuds must be at least age 5 and in Kindergarten as of Jan 1. Project members must be at least age 8 and in 3rd grade as of Jan 1.
- 2. Select a club that meets during the times which work with your family's schedule.
- 3. Look for a club that meets in a place where you are comfortable.
- 4. Decide what kind of projects (non-animal, animal, sewing, shooting sports) your child plans to take and find a club that accepts those kinds of projects.
- 5. Contact the advisor for more detailed club information. Ask about participation/attendance requirements, club dues and fundraising
- 6. Ask what kind of involvement or participation the club expects from the parents.
- 7. Set up a visit to a club meeting. Have fun and enjoy your 4-H Club experience.

If you can't find a club that will work with your family's needs, consider starting a club of your own. Contact the Extension Office for more information on how to become a 4-H Volunteer Club Advisor, it is as rewarding experience. New volunteer applications must be received by February 1.
