2024 EquiSTEP (Equine Safety, Training, and Education Program)

EquiSTEP is an annual statewide requirement for all youth participating in Ohio 4-H Horse Program activities and/or enrolled in a 4-H/FFA horse project. EquiSTEP replaces the statewide requirement of reading the *Horses, Safety, and You* (191R) resource and viewing the *Every Time, Every Ride* and *Horses, Kids, and Ethics* videos for youth and their families who are new to the 4-H horse program.

The EquiSTEP curriculum focuses on helmet safety, equine safety & handling, equine health & nutrition, and sportsmanship and is designed to rotate topics every year.

The EquiSTEP requirement must be completed by **June 1**st. There are two options to complete:


1. Self-Paced Course

To complete EquiSTEP <u>individually</u> each member must have their own email address (do NOT use a school email).

- Each member should sign up for the course at http://go.osu.edu/equistep2024
- Select 'Modules' to see the 5 steps.
- Watch the video(s) that corresponds with each step.
- Complete the quiz associated with the training. You will need to score at least a 7 out of 10 in order to pass the training.
- After scoring at least a 7 out of 10 on the quiz, complete the Certificate of Completion/Course Evaluation Survey. Both you and your county 4-H professional will be emailed a certificate that shows you have completed the EquiSTEP training.
- This certificate of completion is how the Fairfield County 4-H Program knows you have completed the EquiSTEP
- The EquiSTEP course, quiz, and certificate need to be completed by **June 1**st.

If there is one email address (do NOT use a school email) for multiple family members:

- Select 'Modules' to see the 5 steps.
- All horse exhibitors in the family, watch the video(s) that corresponds with each step.
- All horse exhibitors in the family, complete the quiz online at http://go.osu.edu/equistep2024quiz. You will need to score at least a 7 out of 10 in order to pass the training.
- All horse exhibitors in the family complete the Certificate of Completion/Course
 Evaluation Survey (https://osu.az1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_20p6MQhlrrtvlK6) (Both you and your county 4-H professional will be emailed a certificate that notes you have completed the EquiSTEP training.
- This certificate of completion is how the Fairfield County 4-H Program knows you have completed the EquiSTEP.
